COLUMBIA, SC cost from \$3,500 **GUEST COUNT** 400 **ABOUT** The French-inspired architecture of this historic home built in 1855 is what turns heads-just check out the intricate ironwork (above). Fun fact: It's located on the Governor's Mansion complex.

HALF-MILE FARM BY OLD EDWARDS

HIGHLANDS, NC

cost from \$21,200 **GUEST COUNT 100** ABOUT This 19th-century updated farmhouse has all the charm of a B and B with the amenities of a luxury hotel. It's only available to book from May to October.

GREENVILLE, SC cost from \$2,500 **GUEST COUNT 200** ABOUT This property sits on 35 acres and offers totally unobstructed views of the Blue Ridge Mountains, thanks to structures like its timber-frame pavilion.

ASHEVILLE, NC

cost from \$3,950 **GUEST COUNT 200** ABOUT After a ceremony in the beer garden, snap pics in front of the living green wall, then kick off cocktail hour with eight Hi-Wire brews of your choice on tap.
